

Post-emergence herbicide for control of annual broadleaf weeds in wheat, barley and maize.

ACTIVE INGREDIENT: Fluroxypyr-meptyl 200g/L

FORMULATION: Emulsifiable Concentrate (EC)

REGISTRATION NO.: PCPB(CR) 2129

WHO CLASSIFICATION: WHO Class II

MODE OF ACTION: STINGER 200EC contains Fluroxypyr as an active ingredient. It is taken up by foliar and translocated rapidly to other parts of the plant. Its symptoms on weeds are evident through leaf curling, twisting and cupping. On young undeveloped leaves, they become stunted and distorted resulting to chlorosis and death of the weeds.

Wheat, Barley, Maize	Broadleaf weeds	100ml in 20L of water	1.0L in 200L of water	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply at already emerged weeds and when the crop is from 3-leaf stage up to booting (flag leaf) growth stage. • Weeds should only be sprayed in the young stages and when actively growing in moist soil. • Users are advised to always check for crop compatibility / tolerance by treating a few plants before large-scale application. Do not apply STINGER 200 EC if rain is expected within 2 hours. • Make 1 application post emergence.

Re-entry interval (REI): 12 hours

Pre-harvest Interval (PHI): 61 days on Wheat, Barley and Maize

Follow up crops: Do not plant any broadleaf crops for at least 120 days from application.

Mixing instructions

Half-fill the spray tank with water. Add the required amount of Stinger 200EC, then fill with water to the required level and continue with stirring or agitation until the mixture is thoroughly uniform.

Why use Stinger on Wheat, Barley and Maize?

- Very effective of wide range of annual broad-leafed such as wondering jew, black jack, black night shade, double thorn etc.
- Stinger is selective to the wheat, Barley and Maize crop, meaning it will only harm target weeds but does not have effect on wheat, maize and Barley.
- Quick reaction on weeds, stops cell division **hence killing the weeds faster.**
- **Stinger can be used to control even woody brush weed such as Mexican marigold**
